Purpose

Greater West Childcare understands that building respectful relationships with families, partner organisations, and our community is fundamental in providing quality care for children.

1. Family Involvement

Management will strive to build relationships with families that show respect and value their expertise, culture and beliefs. Families will be encouraged to share in decision-making about their child's learning and wellbeing whilst in our care and be involved in the life of the centre.

2. Collaborative Partnerships

Greater West Childcare understands that valuing the contributions of our community and its place in supporting children's wellbeing will benefit the service and the families. As such, we will utilise local services and agencies to support the inclusion of all children and provide for the needs of our community.

3. Enrolment and Orientation

Management will develop and implement an enrolment and orientation process that focuses on creating a smooth transition from home to care for the child and starts building a positive relationship between the family, the service, and other local community partners such as the local church.
